

Installing Google Chrome Authenticator

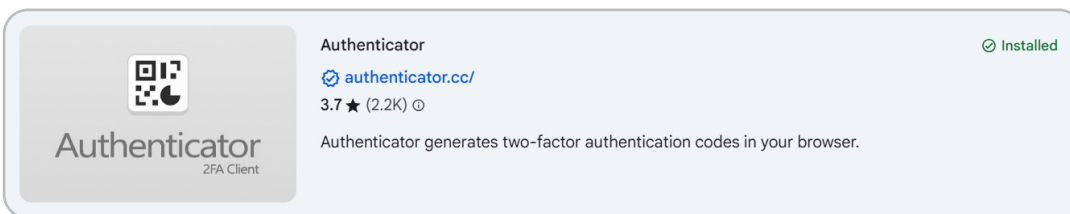
On your desktop computer, follow the below links and steps to set up Google Chrome Authenticator. This will allow you to receive your authentication code to use in Auth0.

1. Open Google Chrome

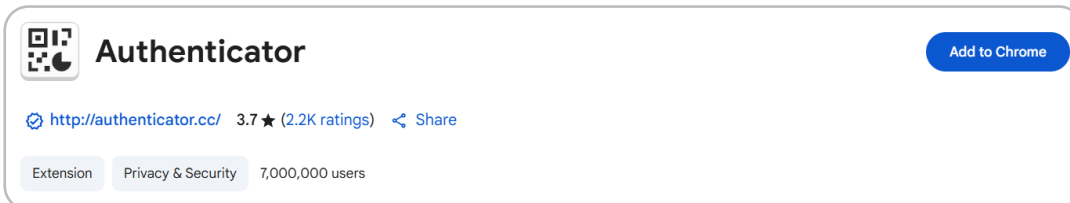
Search for "[Chrome Web Store](#)" or follow the hyperlink in this step.

2. In Chrome Web Store

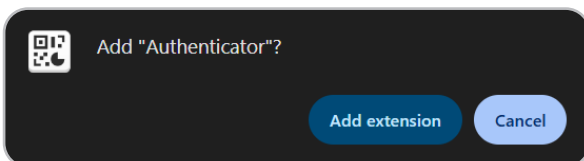
Search for "Authenticator" and select the extension from "authenticator.cc" or follow this link: <https://chromewebstore.google.com/search/Authenticator>



4. Click "Add to Chrome"



5. Click "Add extension"
